Mode: In-person, residency programme

Place: Asian College of Journalism, Chennai

Eligibility:

■ Senior or mid-career journalists in India with **at least 7 years** of experience in climate change/environment reporting.

■ Journalists attached to newsrooms in India and willing to take a break, and independent journalists in India can apply.

Focus: Work on in-depth, investigative multimedia stories on climate change, which can be published in the media.

Programme Support:

■ Boarding and lodging, a stipend, reimbursement of approved production-related expenses for stories, to and fro subsidised travel fare.

■ Capacity building in multimedia tools, interaction with domain experts, access to visual/audio/digital production and post-production facilities, academic resources, library, and online access to specialised journals.
